Welcome to the 2025 Berkshire Grown Guide to Local Food & Farms!

Almost 40 years after its inception, Berkshire Grown continues to keep farmers farming by building and supporting connections between community members and our amazing local farmers and food producers. 2024 was a banner year for Berkshire Grown in our efforts to support our local farms and get their products to a broad range of consumers.

In 2024, Berkshire Grown hosted eight Winter Farmers Markets where shoppers spent over \$150,000 with local vendors. Dozens of farmers gained valuable skills through our technical assistance and workshops on topics including social media, composting, pasture management, grant writing, and ergonomics for farmers.

Berkshire Grown produced and distributed 22,000 copies of this Guide across the county. Most crucially, Berkshire Grown purchased over \$600,000 worth of products directly from 31 local farms, and our community partners distributed that food to 24 food access sites, strengthening food security for more than 14,000 community members across Berkshire County.

Unfortunately, 2025 looks like it will be very different. As funding cuts threaten our Farm to Food Access program and other programs that sustain local farmers, the need to support and develop our local food web is greater than ever. You can help by buying directly from farmers at farmers markets and farm stands, or by joining a CSA program. Tell your grocery store that you want to buy locally grown food, and show your commitment by buying the local products they stock.

This 2025 Guide to Local Food & Farms will help you find farm stands, pick-your-own farms and orchards, as well as local value-added products like charcuterie, preserves, and fermented foods. Within these pages you will find informative descriptions and locations of local farms and food purveyors.

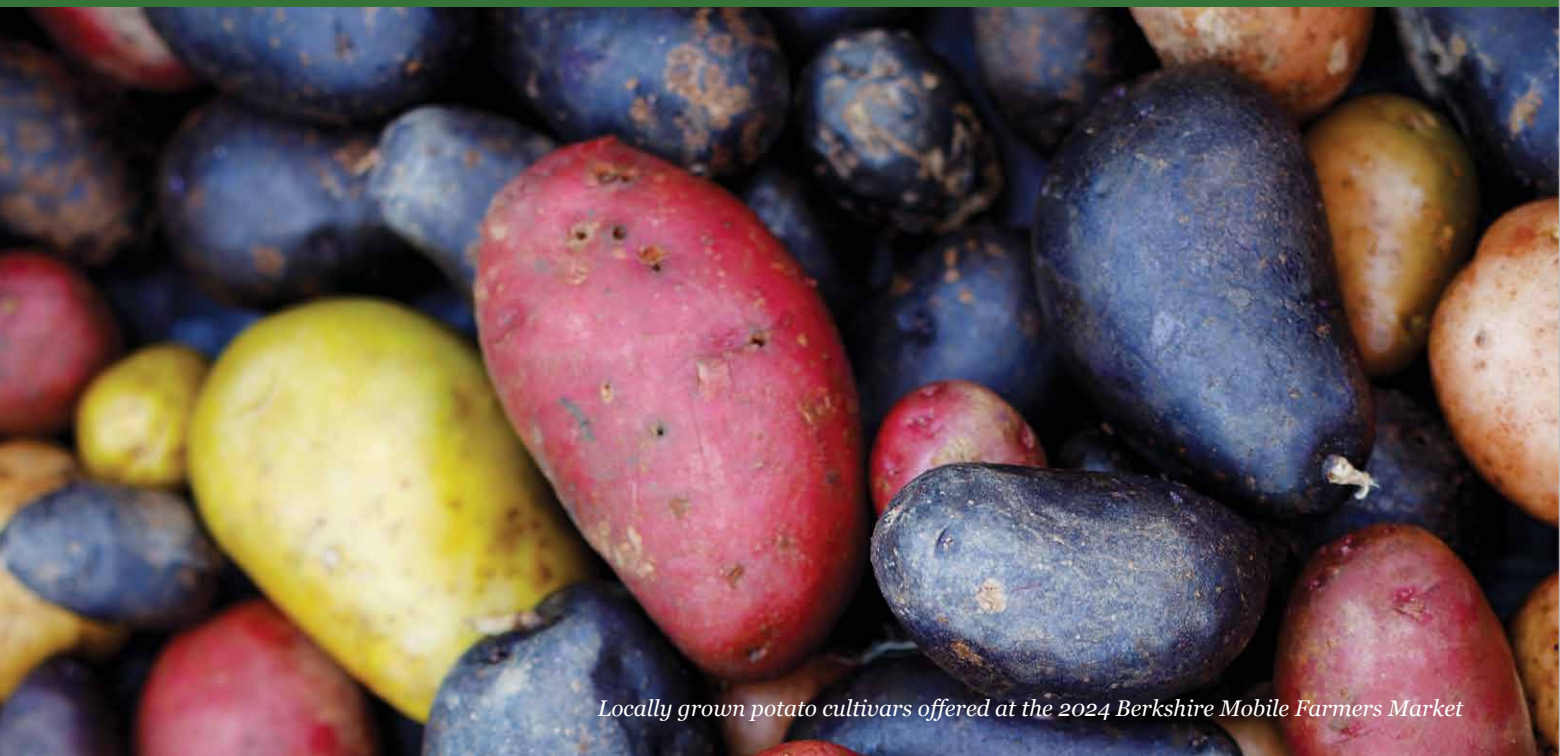



Behind the Scenes: Advocating for Local Food and Farms

Every spring, Berkshire Grown staff members travel to Boston for Massachusetts Agriculture Day. This annual event is a chance to network with other farm-focused organizations from around the state. It also provides the opportunity to meet with state legislators and their staffs, talk about the work we do on behalf of agriculture in the Berkshires, and make recommendations for policy and funding.

This kind of advocacy, while it mostly happens behind the scenes, is a key component of Berkshire Grown's work. Now more than ever, the coordinated activities of organizations like Berkshire Grown and its partners are essential to protect local farms and food from serious threats and ensure access to local food for all.

What are our priorities for 2025? This year, our advocacy aims to create a bulwark against an onslaught of threats to farmers and the local food system. Our goals include fostering agricultural resilience in Massachusetts, protecting our soil and farms from PFAS contamination, and establishing a framework for the long-term sustainability of the Healthy Incentives Program (HIP).

HIP adds an additional healthy boost for shoppers using the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) when they purchase fruit and vegetables directly from farmers at farmers markets, farm stands, or even through CSA programs. The HIP program has proven incredibly successful in helping low-income community members access fresh, local produce, and those added sales support farmers at the same time. We've seen how the 2024 cutbacks in HIP benefits affect our member farms by substantially reducing HIP sales at farmers markets, and we actively advocate for the reinstatement to previous levels of HIP funding from the State.

Berkshire Grown works closely with other local and regional organizations to advocate for farmers at the federal level, stressing the crucial role that local farms play in our food supply chain. Reckless federal funding cuts and freezes have pulled valuable resources from farms, while also sowing uncertainty and anxiety. When we share stories of the direct impact of budgetary decisions with our legislators and the Secretary of Agriculture, we provide real-life examples of how these cuts devastate our food system and endanger the livelihoods of farmers.

Funding cuts, cancellations, and freezes are about more than dollar amounts. They undermine the local food system that so many of us have been working toward—one based on dignity, equity, resilience, sustainability, and community. Facing many threats, farmers persevere. Berkshire Grown will continue to support them on many fronts and advocate for their interests as we work to build a resilient and equitable local food system.

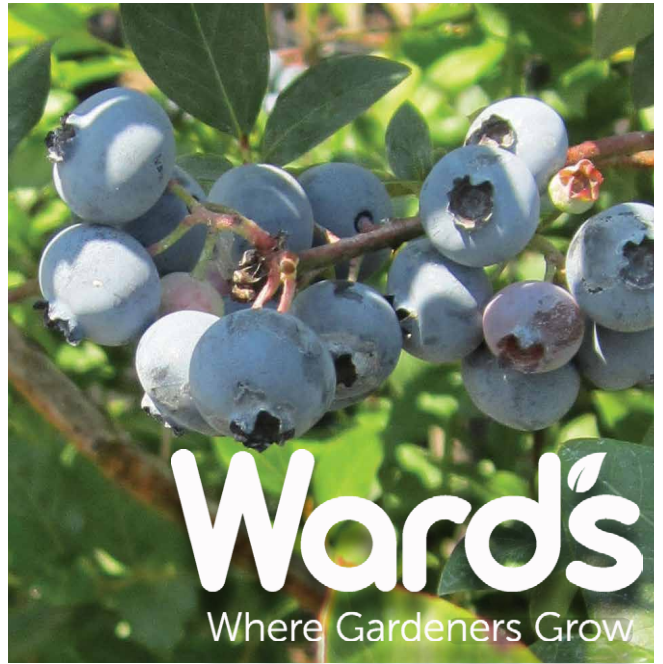

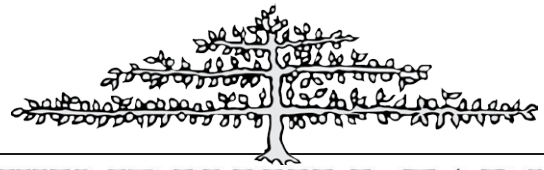

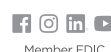
