The old saying “when the going gets tough, the tough get going” can be easily adapted to “when the going gets tough, farmers dig in.” Our farmers aren’t just producing food; they’re stewards of the land, of biodiversity and our local economy. Rooted in our deep appreciation of everything that local farmers provide, Berkshire Grown’s work to “Keep Farmers Farming” is a cornerstone of a vibrant local food system, and that vitality depends on community-wide commitment.

So, when the going gets tough, what can YOU do to support our local farmers?

Buy locally grown food. Purchase directly from farmers at farmers markets, shop at the farm stand down the road, or join a CSA program. What’s on your kitchen table matters—and when you adapt your eating habits to emphasize foods that can be produced in abundance in our region, you help ensure our small-scale farms can continue to grow food for our community.

But farming here isn’t easy. In Massachusetts, farmers make \$0.95 for every \$1 they spend to produce our food; many of our local farmers struggle to pay their bills while keeping their locally grown food affordable. Increasing supply costs, extreme weather events and unpredictable economic upheaval all make small-scale farming a tough row to hoe.

When you buy local food, your dollars go directly to farmers navigating these challenges. But the benefits don’t stop there—they ripple from farms outward across our local economy. So, tell your friends to buy local, too—the more of us who do, the wider those ripples spread.

This 2026 Guide to Local Food & Farms includes informative descriptions and locations of local farms and food purveyors. It will help you find farm stands, pick-your-own orchards and farms, as well as local value-added products like charcuterie, preserves, baked goods, and fermented foods.

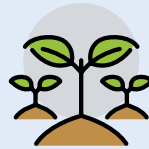
OUR VISION: A strong farm economy and a resilient food system where everyone in the community has access to fresh locally grown food.

SNAP is a federal nutrition program administered by the Department of Transitional Assistance (DTA) in Massachusetts.

SNAP benefits include:

- Monthly funds on a debit-like EBT card to buy food.
- **If you receive SNAP you automatically have access to HIP in Massachusetts!** Get an additional \$40, \$60, or \$80 a month put back on your EBT card when you use SNAP to buy local produce via the **Healthy Incentives Program (HIP)**.
- When you use your SNAP EBT card at Berkshire area farmers markets, you get a 1:1 match up to \$30/ person/ market.

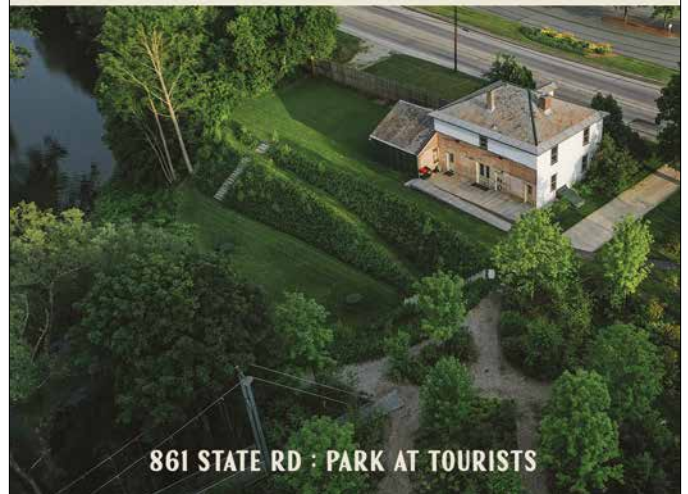

Our Vision: Local Food for Everyone

At Berkshire Grown we believe that everyone should be able to grow, share, and eat fresh, culturally relevant, nutrient-dense food. We also know that prosperous and diverse local farms are essential to this vision. Access to food is a fundamental human right, and we recognize that many people are denied that right.

For over two decades Berkshire Grown has worked with community partners to build a local food system where everyone can fully access their right to food. In 2002 we took on our first farm to food access program, Share the Bounty. Through this program, Berkshire Grown purchases CSA shares from local farms which are delivered to food pantries or donated to low-income CSA members. In 2020, pandemic-fueled disruptions to the food supply chain hit local farmers hard, while

food pantries witnessed a tidal wave of increased need. By leveraging our established relationships with farmers and funders, Berkshire Grown purchased large amounts of local food and worked with community partners to deliver it to food assistance sites.

This initiative grew into our current Farm to Food Access (F2FA) program. F2FA supports local farm businesses by creating a dependable market channel that allows farmers to plan effectively, reduce their financial risk, and keep producing food to meet their community's demand. The program aims to address community health needs while building a more stable and resilient regional food supply.

In 2026, with our program partner Berkshire Bounty, we will raise \$175,000 to continue purchasing local produce, meat and eggs from over 20 farms for distribution to 24 food pantries and other access sites across Berkshire County. By responding to feedback from food access sites and working closely with farmers, we provide community members with food that meets their needs.

The networks and infrastructure we have built through our Farm to Food Access program are the groundwork for a food system based on self-determination and full of abundance. In our vision of a well-balanced local food system, food access work will not be necessary. Farmers will have equitable access to land and resources, and community members can fully support their farmers by buying as much food as possible from local sources.

Many things need to change to make this vision a reality, and most are not in Berkshire Grown's control. Still, we will continue to advocate, collaborate and lean into supporting the food system we envision.

Partner with us to build a better food system! Join a CSA, shop at farmers markets, advocate for local farmers, and share your enthusiasm for local food with your friends and neighbors.

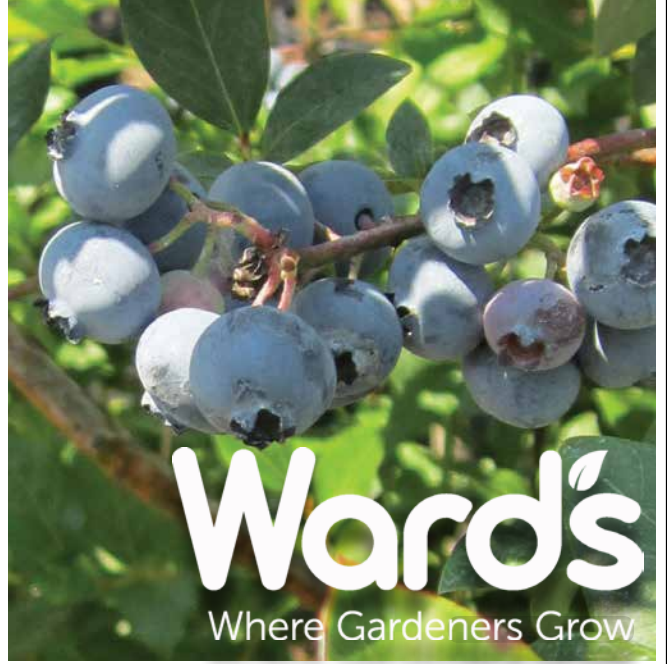

Celebrate the International YEAR OF THE WOMAN FARMER

The United Nations declared 2026 as the International Year of the Woman Farmer to spotlight the essential but often unrecognized roles women play across agrifood systems, from production to trade around the globe. Berkshire Grown is proud to celebrate the women farmers in the Berkshires and their contributions to our local food system.

According to the 2022 USDA Census of Agriculture, women farmers comprise 43% of Massachusetts's farm producers (5,691 women) and steward 297,000 acres of the farmland. More than 47,000 of those acres are nestled into the Berkshires where 200 of Berkshire County farms are at least partly owned and operated by women farmers.

Justamere Tree Farm, located in the Hilltowns of Western Massachusetts, is an all women-owned maple business. Deb Rocque, Kelly Auer and Kim Trust are passionate nature and conservation enthusiasts who met in Alaska in 2004. "We received so much support and encouragement when we started this endeavor in 2020," Trust said. "But we are a minority in a male-dominated field, and we have encountered some individuals who don't take us seriously ... Luckily, we don't take them seriously." Their dedication has translated

into leadership roles in the broader agricultural industry and beyond: Kim Trust is President of the Mass Maple Producers Association Board and represents the maple industry for the State Board of Agriculture. Deb Rocque serves on the town of Worthington's Select Board.

Jamie Nadler of Sugar Snap Gardens in Monterey has noticed that "women are generally more conscious of the toll that farming puts on their bodies and their employees' bodies. In a work setting led by a woman I am reminded more often about my form while working [in the field], and I am encouraged to stretch after a workday." Throughout the Berkshire region, the percentage of women in agriculture continues to grow. Whether they build their own business from the ground up or step in to own and operate an existing farm, women farmers are creating a future agricultural environment in the Berkshires where their priorities and values can take the lead.

Make a point to thank a woman farmer the next time you shop at a farmers market or pick up your CSA share. Ask them about their experience as a farmer to learn more about how women farmers work to get the freshest, most delicious food onto your table.
